Dr. Grisso is Professor, Department of Psychiatry and Director, Law and Psychiatry Program, University of Massachusetts Medical School, Worcester, MA. He received a Ph.D. in Clinical Psychology at the University of Arizona, Tucson, AZ. Dr. Grisso is the recipient of the 2013 Chancellor's Medal for Distinguished Scholarship.

Dr. Grisso's research focuses on policy development and advocacy related to forensic mental health issues in juvenile justice. He has received continuous funding from organizations such as the National Institute of Mental Health, the National Science Foundation, and the MacArthur Foundation. Dr. Grisso is co-developer of the MacArthur Competence Assessment Tools, the MacArthur Violence Risk Assessment Study and the Massachusetts Youth Screening Inventory.
