Abstract: The Robert W. Finberg Papers chronicle Dr. Finberg's career as a physician, researcher, teacher, and administrator at UMass Chan Medical School.

Biographical Note: Robert W. Finberg was born in Baltimore, Maryland and raised in Tarrytown, New York. He earned his undergraduate degree from the University of Chicago and his medical degree, with Alpha Omega Alpha honors, from the Albert Einstein College of Medicine. Dr. Finberg completed his internal medicine residency at the New York University School of Medicine, an Infectious Disease Fellowship at Brigham and Women's Hospital, and his post-doctoral studies at Harvard University. He was an internationally renowned physician-scientist, infectious disease researcher, and teacher whose career spanned more than four decades. Prior to joining UMass Chan Medical School in 1999, Dr. Finberg was professor of medicine at Harvard Medical School and chief of infectious disease at the Dana-Farber Cancer Institute. At UMass Chan he was chair of the Department of Medicine for twenty-one years, directing the clinical, educational, and research activities of the largest academic department, while still caring for patients in the hospital.

Dr. Finberg's research was funded by the National Institutes of Health for over forty years and appeared in more than 300 publications. He was widely recognized as an expert on influenza and Sars-CoV2. He was awarded research grants from the Department of Defense and the Defense

Advanced Research Projects Agency among other agencies. Dr. Finberg was key to the development, testing, and implementation of novel therapies for patients with influenza and SARS-CoV-2 infection. He helped lead clinical trials for SARS-CoV-2 therapeutics and vaccines during the Covid-19 pandemic. An ardent public health advocate, Dr. Finberg served on many state and federal committees to stop the spread of Covid-19 during the pandemic. A citation honoring Dr. Finberg was entered into the Congressional Record of the United States in 2021.

Dr. Finberg served as a member of the Board of Trustees of UMass Memorial Health from 2012 to 2021. He advocated for faculty and staff development and oversaw three residency and fellowship training programs in over 16 specialty and sub-specialty programs. He met with every residency applicant and was a mentor to many students, residents, and faculty.

Dr. Finberg was an avid reader who traveled widely with family and friends, including a climb of Mt. Kilimanjaro. Dr. Finberg died suddenly in 2021, leaving his wife, Dr. Joyce Fingerroth, three daughters, and three grandchildren.

Scope and Content: This collection documents Dr. Finberg's career as a physician, researcher, teacher, and administrator at UMass Chan Medical School. The collection consists of correspondence, reports, and other documents, as well as audio/visual materials.
